

APRIL 2016 WORSHIP COMMISSION MINUTES

- Call meeting to order – All mentioned how their day/week is going.
- **Prayer** – We read and shared from the letter of Paul to the Colossians 3:12-17
- February 2016 minutes were approved as provided.

LITURGICAL MINISTRY UPDATES

- **Ministry Training** Server Training is being worked on. Ushers are needed for Baileys Harbor and Jacksonport masses.
- **Ministry Scheduling Update** Michelle spoke to some of the issues for people updating their profile in order to create the next schedule.

GENERAL OLD BUSINESS

- **Lent 2016 Evaluation**

Lent 2016 theme for Worship guides was “Experience God’s Love and Mercy through the Gospels of Lent”-

Lenten Reflection Books - *Little Black Books* and *Not By Bread Alone* – NBBA –

Rice Bowls not as many were used this year but they are helpful.

Bulletin insert – this was effective to help people know the times of liturgies.

Lenten banner – the banner was well accepted and graced the parish sites.

Ash Wednesday is February 10. Mass times were:

The Baileys Harbor 7:00 PM mass was not well attended.

Year of Mercy pamphlets were handed out on Ash Wednesday.

Father Dave’s homily focus for Lent used the Gospel story of the woman caught in adultery.

Lenten songs - #417, *Mercy, O God* and *Come to Me. “Mercy, O God”*

Soup and Stations of the Cross every Friday noon at Baileys Harbor – Were well received- people liked the new stations book this year written by Fr. Timothy Radcliffe.

The Worship Commission - Mother Mary Catherine from the Missionaries of the Word spoke about **"The Mercy and Discipleship of Blessed Mother Teresa of Calcutta"** on March 3rd in Egg Harbor. Very well received; visitors also attended.

Parish Lenten Reconciliation service - At BH, 3:00 PM on March 17th. More people there than expected around 40, compared to 20-25 at previous Reconciliation services, so perhaps changing the time to the afternoon was effective.

Kathy suggests having the reconciliation service at Fish Creek, possibly during the Triduum Week since Fish Creek is now known as our Triduum location. Fish Creek is centrally located, on one level, and can accommodate more priests, if we need 3. Watching people trying to walk up and down the steps at Baileys Harbor was very disconcerting, worrying about parishioners tripping and falling on the stairs. Years ago, we tried using the room where the lift is located as a reconciliation room, and someone used it during the middle of someone's confession, so that option wasn't and isn't going to work. There aren't many places at BH that are on one level; hopefully, with brainstorming, there might be other solutions.

Fr. Mentioned it is also suggested to switch Christmas and Easter between Baileys Harbor and Fish Creek.

- **Year of Mercy banner update** – Not sure if anyone is noticing them. The file wasn't the right size to be printed by the banner company, so the best we could do was to print them in-house and glue them on a blue background paper. Depending upon the church, they fall down all the time.

Christian Unity Prayer Service – Sunday, February 14th at 3:00 pm in Sister Bay

Bethel Baptist won the UNI Award, they also brought their Praise Band which was great.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick - weekend of **Feb. 20-21**. Went well and many people experienced the anointings.

Triduum / Easter 2016 Evaluation

1. **PALM / PASSION SUNDAY-** It might be better to collect the old palms one week earlier so there is no confusion between the old and new on Palm Sunday.
2. **TRIDUUM REHEARSAL-** Rehearsal went well.
3. **HOLY THURSDAY (98)-** Numbers most likely down due to snow storm.
 - The ringing of the bells at the Gloria was fantastic!
 - This year, it appeared that some of the people having their feet washed didn't know what to do with their chairs at the end. Perhaps in the future, we would have a sheet to give them explaining the process. Or, if we have enough people ahead of time, they can meet with the Master of Ceremonies before Mass begins.
 - Father wants the Song for the Oils by Rosemary Campbell sung for next year. He didn't want it in previous years. This will also smooth out the ritual for presenting the Sacred Oils.

- Mary suggested opening up the wall more so that people could actually see what was going on at the Altar of Repose. Perhaps they'd also be more inclined to spend a little more time in silent prayer after the Mass.
- Positive comments on the choir, servers, readers, etc.

4. GOOD FRIDAY (154)

- Kathy is going to add additional directions on the worship guide; people responded too early to the sung General Intercessions.
- Greg and Connie did a fine job holding the candles and servers did a great job during the adoration of the cross.
A number of people commented on feeling rushed during the adoration time. They wanted to be able to show their love and thanks in their own way. Our cross is not real big and perhaps we need to allow folks to come approach the cross as they see fit. Let's re-visit our decision to encourage people to venerate the cross two by two. An additional comment was made that silent veneration is also desirable.
- Highlighting had been changed for the readers, so there was a slight mix-up and delay in beginning the reading of the Passion.
- With only having two bread ministers, the choir should be instructed to take communion first using the center aisle.

5. EASTER VIGIL (123)

- The RCIA portion of the liturgy was beautiful with Angela being received into the Church.
- There were several glitches in the music from Kathy's perspective. Choir members were not always on track and some seemed confused trying to keep all the ritual music in order. Mary suggested possibly having a temporary director to help keep the choir members on the right page at the right time.
- Excellent job by all the readers!
- Ushers did a great job.
- There was a little mix-up with the lights being turned on too high and too soon. Next year, just have one person in charge of turning on the lights before the Exultet is sung.
- Sacristans forgot to turn off sound system after the Vigil. Kathy found it still turned on Monday morning. We will add this task to the job list
