There were 12 women present. The prayer to Our Lady of Good Council was read.

The minutes from the August meeting were read. Chris Schorer made a motion to approve, second by Judy Roy. Minutes approved as written.

The Treasurer's report was given by Char Mueller. Those not paying their current dues were asked to do so as we need to submit our council dues to the DCCW by November 1. June Nirschl made a motion to approve, second by Judy Roy.
