Connie Brandt called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. Eleven members were present. All attendees read the Mission and Vision Statements and the Prayer to Our Lady of Good Counsel.

Program: Dave and Joyce Detert presented information about the BRIDGES of Friendship to International Students in Door County. They provided an overview of their program and handed out a brochure that listed the number of participating students by country, participating businesses, and the program's activities.
